

How to: Release / Renew an IP address in Windows 2000

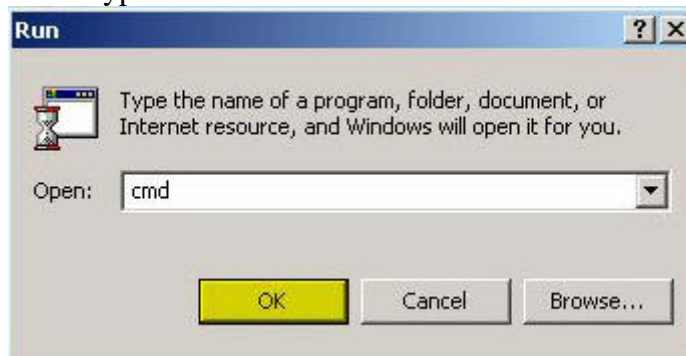

The following instructions will walk you through how to view, release, or renew your IP address for Windows 2000.

1. To view your current IP configuration, begin by clicking the **Start** button, select **Run**. Type **CMD** in the run box and click **OK**.



2. At the C:Windows prompt, type **ipconfig**, and hit **Enter** on the keyboard. To release your IP Address, type **ipconfig/release**, and hit **Enter** on the keyboard. To renew your IP Address, type **ipconfig/renew**, and hit **Enter** on the keyboard.
