1. Click **Start**.
2. Select **Settings** and click **Control Panel**.
3. Double-click the **Network** icon.
4. For each TCP/IP entry select it and click **Remove**.
5. Once all TCP/IP entries are removed click **OK**.
6. Restart the computer.
7. Click **Start**.
8. Select **Settings** and click **Control Panel**.
9. Double-click the **Network** icon.
10. Click **Add**.
11. Choose **Protocol** and click **Add** again.
12. In the Manufacturers box choose **Microsoft**. In the Network Protocols box choose **TCP/IP**. Click **OK**.
13. Click **OK** in the Network window.
14. When prompted to restart the computer choose **Yes**.
