

How to: Setup TCP / IP using Windows 98, and ME

▶ Summary

Refers to setting up the Windows 98 network configuration (TCP/IP) for Lindsey Communications High Speed Internet.

▶ Manual Solution

1. On the desktop double click My Computer double click Control Panel then double click Network.
2. Click the Configuration tab.
3. If you are modifying the current settings, proceed to step 6 below. If this is the initial configuration, choose Add.
4. On the Select Network Component Type window, highlight Protocol and choose Add.
5. On the Select Network Protocol window under Manufacturers, highlight Microsoft. Under Network Protocols, highlight TCP/IP. Choose OK.
6. Highlight the TCP/IP associated with your Ethernet NIC and choose Properties. The TCP/IP Properties window will open. On each tab, make the following settings.
7. Choose the IP Address tab. Click the Obtain an IP address automatically radio button.
8. For Windows ME only: Click the Detect connection to network media radio button.
9. Choose the WINS Configuration tab. Click the Disable WINS Resolution radio button.
10. Choose the Advanced tab. Ensure that the Property setting is None and that Set this protocol to be the default protocol is checked.
11. Choose the Gateway tab. If any addresses are entered in the Installed Gateways box, highlight each one and choose Remove until all have been removed.
12. Choose the DNS Configuration tab. Click the Disable DNS radio button and choose OK.
13. Choose OK to save the settings and close the Network Configuration window.
14. Restart the computer.
