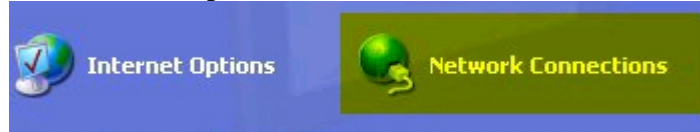

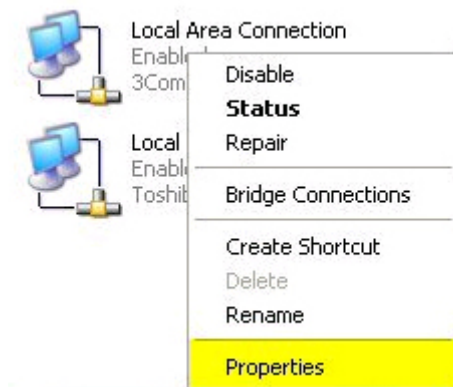
1. To begin, click **Start**, select **Control Panel**.
2. Click **Network and Internet Connections**.



3. When asked to pick a task, **choose Network Connections** at the bottom.



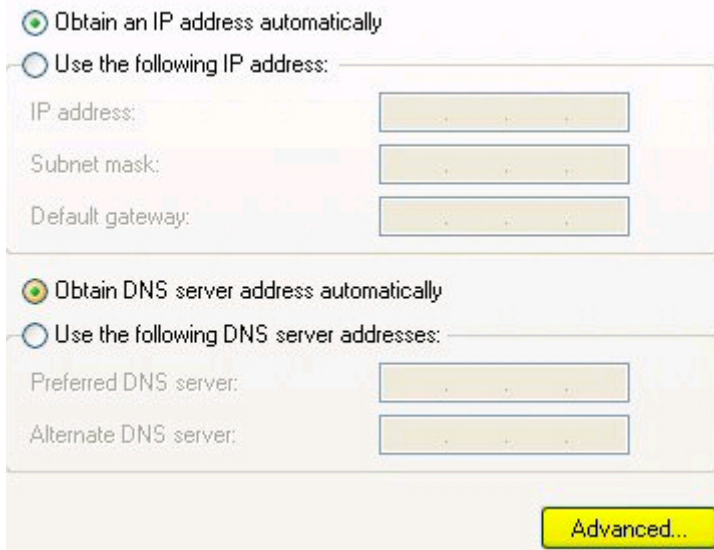
4. Right-click on your **Local Area Connection**, select **Properties**.



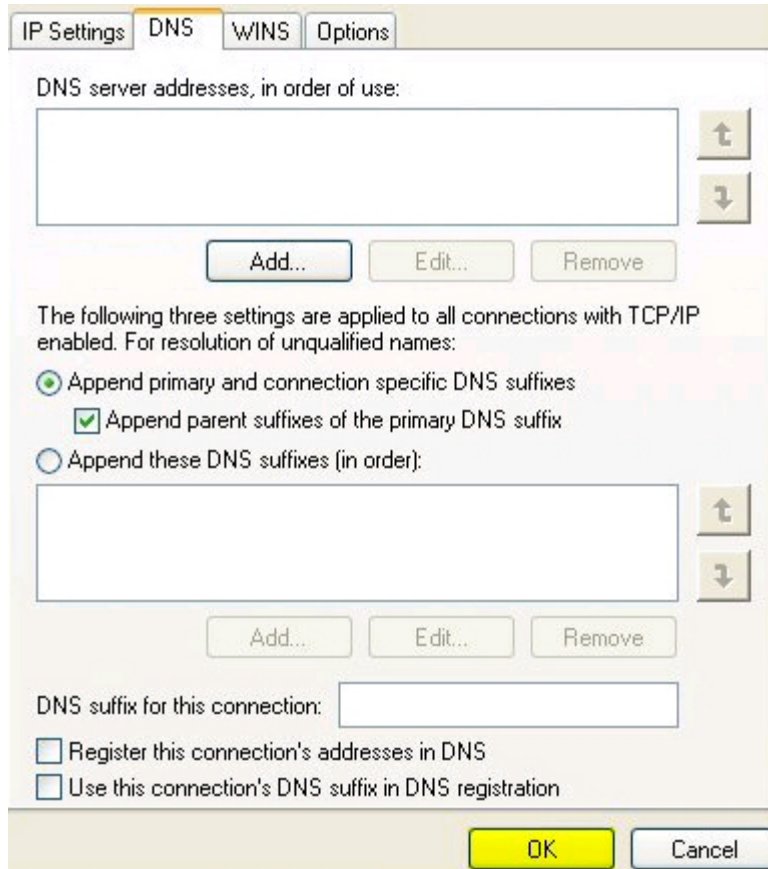
5. Select your Internet **Protocol (TCP/IP)**, and click **Properties**.



6. Verify both the **IP Address** and the **DNS** are set to **obtain automatically**. Once those are correct, click the **Advanced** button.



7. Click the **DNS** tab, remove the check beside **Register this connection's addresses in DNS**.



8. Click **OK** to close the Advanced Options.
9. Click **OK** to close the TCP/IP Properties.
